ITINERARY

Day 1 - Baku

Arrive in Baku. Meet your driver at the airport for a transfer to your hotel. Overnight in Baku. (D)

Day 2 - Baku

Today, set out on a mesmerizing exploration of Baku, a city where the ancient and the contemporary exist in perfect harmony. Start at Upland Park, the highest vantage point in Baku, offering stunning panoramic views of the cityscape and the glistening Caspian Sea. Next, journey into the heart of history as you explore *Icheri Sheher*, Baku's UNESCO-listed Old City. Once enclosed by fortress walls and encompassing the entire city until the mid-19th century, this compact yet captivating area spans just 22 hectares. Within its ancient walls, you'll discover cultural gems such as the elegant Shirvanshah's Palace, the mysterious Maiden Tower, and the atmospheric Karavansaray, which once welcomed weary traders. Meander through the maze of narrow streets, where a close-knit community of 1,300 families continues to keep the spirit of this historic enclave alive. Conclude your day with a visit to Fountains Square, a vibrant gathering spot where you can unwind, take in the local atmosphere, or enjoy some shopping. Overnight in Baku. (B, D)

Day 3 - Baku - Gobustan - Yanardag - Baku

Prepare for an exhilarating day as we uncover some of Azerbaijan's most extraordinary natural and cultural wonders. Start your journey with a visit to Gobustan National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site famed for its ancient rock carvings. These remarkable petroglyphs, some over 40,000 years old, depict scenes of hunting, rituals, and everyday life, offering a fascinating glimpse into the world of prehistoric communities. Stroll through this open-air gallery and immerse yourself in the stories etched into the stone. From here, venture to one of Azerbaijan's most intriguing geological marvels-its mud volcanoes. With nearly half of the world's mud volcanoes located here, Azerbaijan offers an otherworldly landscape where bubbling craters and slow-moving mudflows create a surreal and captivating scene. These natural phenomena are not only a spectacle to behold but are also believed to possess therapeutic qualities. In the afternoon, visit Yanar Dag, the famous "Burning Mountain," where natural gas seeping from the earth has fed a continuous flame for centuries. This enchanting fire dances along the hillside, casting a warm glow and reminding visitors why Azerbaijan is known as the "Land of Fire." Experience the mystical allure of this natural wonder as the flames illuminate the surrounding landscape. Return to Baku in the evening to relax after an unforgettable day. Overnight in Baku. (B, D)

Day 4 - Baku - Gala - Ateshgah - Ramana - Baku

Embark on an enchanting journey to uncover the cultural treasures and mystical sites of Azerbaijan. Begin your day at the Gala Archaeological and Ethnographic Museum Complex, an open-air museum that brings Azerbaijan's ancient heritage to life. Explore reconstructed dwellings, ancient tools, and artifacts that showcase the daily lives, traditions, and craftsmanship of the region's early inhabitants. Wander through this immersive display and connect with the history of rural Azerbaijan. Next, head to Ateshgah, the famed Fire Temple of Baku, a site that symbolizes Azerbaijan's deep-rooted association with fire worship. Return to Baku in the evening to unwind after a day rich in history and discovery. Overnight in Baku. (B, D)

Day 5 - Baku

Begin your day with a leisurely walk along Baku Boulevard, a picturesque promenade lining the Caspian Sea. Conclude your day with free time at Park Boulevard Mall, a stylish shopping destination near the Caspian Sea. Browse the array of shops, relax at a chic cafe ☺, or simply soak in the lively atmosphere of this bustling retail hub. Overnight in Baku. (B, D)

Day 6 - Baku - Shamakhi - Lahich - Gabala

Embark on a picturesque drive to Gabala, immersing yourself in the serene beauty of Azerbaijan's countryside. Along the way, make a stop in Shamakhi, a city steeped in history and surrounded by breathtaking landscapes. Begin with a visit to the Juma Mosque, a remarkable 8th-century structure renowned for its timeless design and tranquil ambiance. Then, explore the Shamakhi Mausoleum, a historical site that houses the resting places of notable figures, offering a blend of cultural significance and natural splendor. The rolling vineyards and orchards of the region add to its idyllic charm. Continue your journey to the mountain village of Lahich, a living museum of Azerbaijani craftsmanship. Stroll through its cobblestone streets lined with traditional workshops, where skilled artisans create exquisite copperware using techniques passed down through generations. As the day unfolds, arrive in Gabala, nestled in the verdant foothills of the majestic Caucasus Mountains. Surrounded by lush scenery, this tranquil town provides the perfect setting to unwind after a day of exploration. Overnight in Gabala. (B, D)

Day 7 - Gabala - Gabala - Sheki

Start your day with an exploration of Gabala, a picturesque town nestled at the foot of the majestic Caucasus Mountains. Day 9 - Ganja - Ganja - Goygol - Baku

Begin your day in Ganja, Azerbaijan's vibrant second city, steeped in history and culture. Visit the Shah Abbas Mosque, a masterpiece of Islamic architecture, and explore the medieval caravanserai, once a lively hub for Silk Road traders. Discover the Museum of Miniature Books, a fascinating collection showcasing literary works in a

diminutive format, and marvel at the quirky Bottle House, an artistic landmark constructed from glass bottles. Pay homage to the celebrated Azerbaijani poet Nizami Ganjavi at his grand mausoleum, a cultural treasure. Wrap up your Ganja exploration with a visit to the bustling local bazaar, soaking in the sights, sounds, and flavors of the city. Continue to the picturesque town of Goygol, where the charming village of Xanlar (formerly Helenendorf) offers a unique blend of Azerbaijani and German heritage. Established in 1819 by German settlers, the village boasts tree-lined streets, quaint German-style architecture, and an old Lutheran church that now houses a museum. Explore the local history museum to learn about the region's Bronze Age roots, German settlement history, and the poignant stories of deportations during Stalin's era. After this enriching day, return to Baku, where you'll spend the evening at leisure. Overnight in Baku. (B, D)

Day 10 - Baku

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your flight home. (B)
